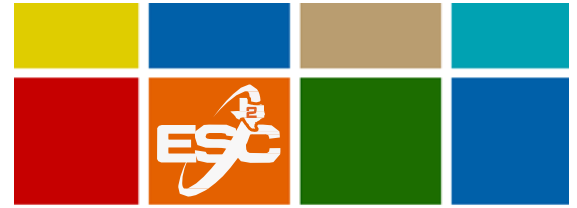

A multi-tiered approach to empowering teachers and building capacity

Focusing on Quality Lesson Plans



Empowering Teachers and Building Capacity is a partnership between ESC-2 and participating districts with the goal of developing quality lesson plans.

This professional development is a multi-tiered effort designed to meet the specific needs of educators who want to learn more about writing effective lessons. Tier 1 is a six-hour training focused on the four aspects of a quality lesson plan: writing objectives; calibrating learning activities and resources; strategies for assessing student understanding; and reflective practices to improve instruction.

In Tiers 2 & 3, ESC-2 consultants and teacher cohorts leverage the tools in Project Share and Adobe Connect to participate in online, facilitated planning sessions. Instruction will take place in Adobe Connect. Participants may attend each session one of three ways; face-to-face at a host site, live online, or view the recorded session. Participants then use group tools, such as the Wiki and the Forum, to collaboratively write lessons, all under the facilitated guidance of ESC-2 specialists.
